DID YOU KNOW?



Many People Needed: We currently have two main areas of the parish where people are needed: employees and volunteers. Here's a general update:

Employees: We are currently looking to fill the positions of Parish Secretary, Bookkeeper, Music Director, and Maintenance Specialist. The job descriptions of all these positions are available both in the church vestibules, and also by emailing me at frpmj@stmarycmu.org However, it's also possible (depending on an applicant's qualifications) that two part-time positions could be combined into a single full-time position (Secretary/Bookkeeper, Secretary/Music Director, etc.) My goal is to have all these positions filled *before* CMU's academic year begins in late August. The parish needs to be fully staffed before 20,000 students arrive in Mount Pleasant.

Volunteers: We're also in need of many people to volunteer at the parish. Here are the areas most in need:

Lectors. We need people to proclaim the Scripture readings at Mass and to lead the Prayers of the Faithful. I know that speaking in public might sound a little scary, but it's a beautiful ministry. I can always schedule a training session for people interested in this ministry (and also for those currently volunteering). Lectors don't necessarily need to be over 18. I've heard some fantastic lectors who are in junior high.



Ushers. We need people to greet and hand out songbooks as people arrive, to take up the collection, and to hand out bulletins as people leave. Ushers also give basic information to visitors (location of restrooms, times of reconciliation, first aid kit, etc.) This ministry is open to men, women, families, and teenagers.

Altar Servers. Like ushers, altar servers can be men, women, and teenagers. It helps me out a lot to have even one altar server at Mass. Because altar servers carry the processional cross and light candles, they should at least be in the 5th grade.

Cantors. Admit it, you sing in the car. Ever thought about leading the people in song at Mass?

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. There are more requirements for this ministry, and the Diocese requires attendance at a formation session (the next one is this Thursday, July 26th, inside St. Cecilia Church in Clare, from 6:30-8:00 pm.

Altar Linens. We also need people to launder the linens and towels used at Mass. I have information on the procedures for this.

Money-Counters. As I announced last weekend, we need volunteers on Monday to count the collection. The parish office has all the forms needed, and we can help you with the procedure, but we need volunteers to actually do the counting (Diocesan policy.)

I'll keep the parish regularly updated on the employee situation, and we'll continue to look at volunteers, especially once the academic year begins.
