**The Inferno in California:**

As you know, the city of Paradise in northern California has been lost to a massive wildfire which at times traveled at 60 miles an hour. That city was almost exactly the size of Mount Pleasant in population. I say "was" because the city is gone. To fully comprehend the magnitude of this catastrophe, let's imagine that a raging wildfire swept through Mount Pleasant with the same results. Mount Pleasant has over 3,000 businesses. Imagine Mission and Pickard Streets and the Downtown area having nothing but charred ruins. There are over 7,000 houses in Mount Pleasant. Only chimneys would be left. There are over 70 churches. 20 schools. 19 nursing homes. All burned to nothing. Over 25,000 people homeless. With all the hotels gone and the schools burned down, there's no place for people to stay. The hospital is blackened rubble. Imagine that you're one of the people who lost everything. All you have is what you're wearing. Even your photographs are gone.



And all of this happens one week before Thanksgiving.
