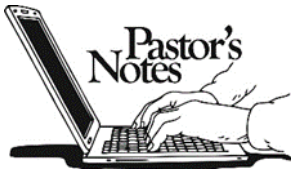

## Holy Week Schedule:

Holy Thursday (6 pm) We begin the evening with a special liturgy called The Mass of the Lord's Supper. We celebrate the institution of the Eucharist and perform the ritual of foot-washing, a powerful sign of the Lord's love. If you'd like to experience the foot-washing, simply sit at a chair which has a towel draped on it. After Communion, the Eucharist is moved to a special place of reposition. If you're not staying to pray, we ask that you leave in silence and save any visiting for outside.



Good Friday (Stations of the Cross at 12 noon; Passion Service at 1 pm) As you enter the church on Good Friday, please do so in silence and save any visiting for later. The sanctuary is bare and the tabernacle is empty. The passion narrative from John's gospel is always used on Good Friday, and the wood of the cross is carried in for veneration. The Passion Service has no formal ending, and people either leave in silence, or stay in church for silent prayer.



The Easter Vigil (9 pm) People enter a semi-darkened church. A holy fire is lit and the new Paschal candle is lighted from it. The light is slowly spread throughout the church. The water in the font is blessed and baptism are celebrated. New members of the Church are confirmed in the Faith and receive the Eucharist for the first time. By far, the Easter Vigil is the Catholic Church's most spectacular liturgy.



Easter Sunday (6 pm) Because so many students go home for Easter, we're having Sunday Mass only at 6 pm.

Weekday Mass and Reconciliation: During Holy Week, weekday Mass is Tuesday at 9 pm and Wednesday at 6 pm. Reconciliation is Wednesday from 7:30-8:30 pm.

**NOTE: There is no reconciliation on Holy Saturday.**

**Rice Bowls:** Remember to bring your rice bowls back to church on Holy Thursday. They will be brought forward during the Presentation of the Gifts and placed at the foot of the altar.



**New Assignment:** As I announced last Sunday, this summer I'm moving to a new parish in the Diocese. Beginning July 1<sup>st</sup>, I will be Pastor of Blessed Trinity Parish in Frankenmuth. The Diocese is still finalizing plans for the sacramental and pastoral needs of St. Mary's, and I will make the specifics known as soon as possible. In the meantime, we'll continue pursuing parish projects and repairs, and I'll be putting updates in the bulletin on a regular basis.
